Executive Director Erik Glenn shares more details about the upcoming Land Trust's annual fundraiser the Sunset BBQ which will be held near Colorado Springs.

Glenn: "So this year's BBQ will take place on Saturday, July 11th. At the Johnson/Hammond Family's Elk Ranch. So it's a pretty neat property and it has been in production agriculture throughout its existence. It's been in the same family since it was homesteaded. It is a beautiful location for the celebration of 20 years of conservation. This is the Cattlemen's Land Trust's 20th anniversary — so it is an exciting time for us and an exciting location to celebrate some great work over the last two decades."
